Thank you for booking a place at this year's Symposium & Exhibition. This document provides joining instructions and other information relating to this event and the MOVA User Group which is being held the day before the Symposium.

### Location

The Symposium is being held at the Conference Park Campus of the University of Warwick. A location plan and directions to the campus are attached. Please note that complimentary car parking is provided, however you must follow the instructions below.

### By Road

A map is attached with comprehensive directions for arriving by car.

### By Rail

Coventry Intercity Station is on the Main West Coast Line with regular trains connecting with other major towns and cities. Trains run every half hour to London. Services to Birmingham International and Birmingham New Street are frequent throughout the day. There is a large taxi rank at Coventry Station, just four miles from the Conference Park. Alternatively, a regular bus service is also available.

### By Air

Birmingham International Airport is only 20 minutes by taxi. A frequent train service operates to Coventry from Birmingham International Station, adjacent to the airport. Coventry Airport is situated at Baginton and is just 15 minutes from the Conference Park.

### **Car Parking**

The University has a number of car parks on campus. You are free to use any car park within the Central Campus of the University which is non-barriered (see attached campus map). It is now each individual's responsibility to register for a parking permit. You must display a parking permit in the vehicle at all times. If you fail to print and display the permit, you will be required to pay on foot. Failure to do so may result in a parking fine. The University car parks are monitored by an external company.

As a University campus, from time to time these car parks become full and when this happens alternative parking will be available, which you will be directed to. Accessible parking spaces are available in all car parks. Blue badge holders may request an accessible parking space close to accommodation, please get in touch to do this.

### Accommodation

If you have booked accommodation on campus please check in at the Conference Reception located within the Students Union Building. Rooms are available from 15:00 until 22:45. Bedrooms must be vacated by 09:30 on the day of departure and keys must be returned to the Conference Reception, Rootes Restaurant or the boxes situated in the entrance halls of each residence, otherwise you will be charged £10 + vat for any

lost cards. Your room will have tea and coffee making facilities, free internet access and towels and toiletries will be supplied. Reception staff will be on hand in the Conference Reception within the Students Union Building between 07:00 and 23:00 and you can contact reception on 02476 528910.

- Fill in your details and you will be sent a password by text.
- If you are unable to use your mobile phone then at the bottom of the page use
   Click Here to register and the details will be sent to your email address. Please
   ask a member of staff if you need access to a computer to retrieve your login
   details.
- Return to the main login page and enter your details. You may use up to three devices simultaneously and your account will be valid for one week.

If you have any problems connecting then please speak to any member of the team.

### **MOVA User Group**

The MOVA User Group is being held on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> September – the day before the Symposium. It will be held in the Humanities Building. It will start at 11:00 and refreshments will be served from 10:30 outside the room, alongside registration. Lunch will be provided in Rootes Restaurant, a ticket for lunch will be provided at registration. The day is funded by Siemens, telent, Dynniq, TRL, PTV & ITS and JCT make no charge for organising the event.

### **Symposium**

The Symposium presentations will take place in the **new Oculus Teaching and Learning building** opposite Warwick Arts Centre which is where the Exhibition will take place. Registration for the Symposium on Wednesday morning will take place at the Conference Reception within the Atrium of the Student Union Building from 08:30 – 09:20 and thereafter in the Exhibition, which will be held in the Arts Centre's Butterworth Hall.

The Symposium presentations will take place in the brand **new Oculus Lecture Theatre** and will start at 09:30 prompt on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> and will finish at approximately 16:00 on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> September.

- From M69 /M6 interchange (M6 Jct 2) take A46 towards Warwick and Coventry S & E.
- After approx 3.5 miles you will reach Tollbar End roundabout (junction with A45). At the roundabout, follow signs for A45 Birmingham.
- After approx 3 miles you will cross the A429 (Kenilworth Road).
   Half a mile after this junction take the left-hand turn signposted
  'University of Warwick' (Fire Station on left, Police Station on right).
   Follow signs for University of Warwick (and Warwick Arts Centre) across
  two roundabouts. You are now approaching The University of Warwick
  from Kirby Corner Road.
- · Follow Maps 3 and 4 for your meeting location.

#### From the South East


- · From M45 Jct 1 take A45 towards Coventry.
- After approx 7 miles you will reach Tollbar End roundabout (junction with A46) follow signs for A45 Birmingham.
- Now follow the directions given in the third bulletpoint above.
- · Follow Maps 3 and 4 for your meeting location.

#### From the South

- · From M40 Jct 15 take A46 towards Coventry.
- After approximately 8 miles leave A46 at junction signposted 'University of Warwick' and turn left.
- Take the second exit at the mini roundabout and continue for a further mile on the Stoneleigh Road, crossing the A429 Kenilworth Road.
   You are now approaching The University of Warwick from Gibbet Hill Road.
- Follow Maps 3 and 4 for your meeting location.

#### From the West

- · From M42 Jct 6 take A45 towards Coventry.
- After approximately 9 miles you will pass a large Sainsbury's store on your left. At the next roundabout (Fire Station on right, Police Station on left), take the right-hand exit, signposted 'University and Canley'.
- Follow signs for University of Warwick (and Warwick Arts Centre) across two roundabouts. You are now approaching The University of Warwick from Kirby Corner Road.
- · Follow Maps 3 and 4 for your meeting location.



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
